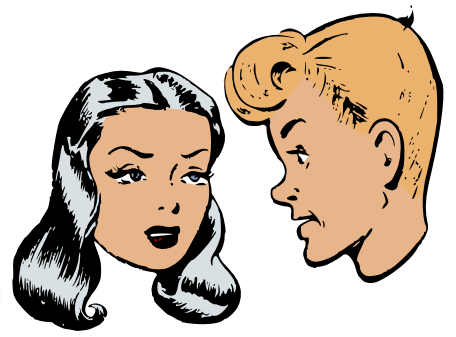


VIDEO CONTENT FOR KIDS

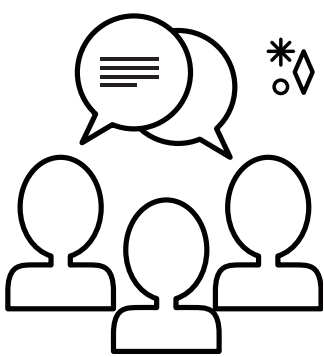


SOCIAL MEDIA POSTS
